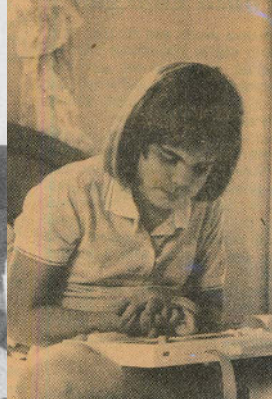

Bello Machre means *home of my heart* in Gaelic. This meaning is reflected in our mission: a lifetime commitment of loving care, opportunities, and guidance for people with developmental disabilities in Maryland. For over 50 years, we have provided residential and community-based services that help those we support live rich, fulfilling lives.

Employing over 400 skilled professionals, we have the capability to serve 180 people in 50 community homes throughout Central and Western Maryland. Bello Machre also provides help and support to more than 200 children, adults, and families in their own homes and communities.

The Jesse and Hertha Adams Ray of Hope Program provides assistance to help meet the needs of individuals and families. From specialized summer camp to physical therapy and adaptive equipment expenses, Bello Machre will help families no matter the challenges they face.

Personal Supports Services pair Direct Support Professionals with individuals in a one to one setting. The people we support receive access to community-based social, educational, and leisure activities, helping them to thrive and grow.

Meaningful Day Services include Community Development Services and Employment Services; both provide community-based adult day services. Community Development Services include social, recreational, and volunteer opportunities in a small group setting so that the people we support can be active members of the community. Employment Services focus on helping your loved one find competitive employment opportunities in the community.

Residential Services offer care for people in Bello Machre-owned homes where they feel safe and loved. A Family Living Director (house manager) and other Direct Support Professionals guide and help those we serve so they can grow, develop, and live life to the fullest.

Bello Machre is a 501(c) (3) organization registered with the Maryland Secretary of State, regulated by the Maryland Department of Health, and licensed by the Maryland Office of Health Care Quality. We serve children, adults, and families without regard to race, religion, gender, or national origin.

We Nurture, We Teach, We Care *for people with developmental disabilities*

An impossible dream became a reality.

A 50 year journey — together!

Fifty years ago, we embarked on a journey that most people said was impossible, says Dr. Robert Ireland, President and CEO of Bello Machre. Today, we stand as proof that not only do all people deserve a life filled with meaning and happiness, but that this goal is attainable.

In the early 1970s, a group of parents who had children with developmental disabilities joined together with a unifying concern — who would take care of their children when they were gone? At the time, options and resources were scarce. Parents would often care for their children at home, knowing that the only alternative was an institution lacking privacy and personal enrichment.

These parents wanted more for their children. They wanted to know that when they were gone, their children would still be able to experience a lifetime of happiness and loving care. *We wanted to know that our children could live rich, meaningful lives in safe, loving homes*, say founding parents Tom and Janet Jenkins. It was this desire for a better future that spurred the creation of Bello Machre.

Bello Machre opened its doors in 1972, offering loving homes for people with developmental disabilities on its campus. By the early 1980s, Bello Machre expanded with the opening of its first community home in Glen Burnie. The transition to community homes was the start of Residential Services.

Today, Bello Machre has 50 fully-accessible homes throughout Anne Arundel and Carroll Counties supporting 200 people. Through Residential, Personal Supports, and Meaningful Day Services, Bello Machre continues to provide leading-edge and innovative resources for people with developmental disabilities. Our mission, though, remains the driving force behind everything we do: to provide a lifetime of loving care, guidance, and opportunities to the people we serve.

I cannot fathom a world without Bello Machre, says Dave Wynkoop, parent and Board Member. Because of Bello Machre, I have peace of mind knowing that my daughter, Kathryn, will always be taken care of by wonderful people in a beautiful home. He adds, Bello Machre has also provided a world of enrichment in the community — from aiding Kathryn in securing jobs to exciting activities like Every Step Counts.

We're so grateful for Bello Machre, says founding parent Bel. Her daughter, Belinda, has been with Bello Machre since it opened in 1972.

Bel was living in West Virginia when she gave birth to Belinda. During childbirth, Belinda experienced a lack of oxygen which led to an extended stay at the hospital.

When Bel moved to Maryland so that Belinda could receive specialized care at Johns Hopkins Children's Center, she learned that Belinda had sustained permanent brain damage. Bel felt lost and alone, but found support from other parents facing similar challenges. All of the parents shared a uniting concern — what would the future hold for their children?

That's when the dream of Bello Machre was born. Bel and the other parents worked together to create a program that would provide the support their children needed.

50 years later, Belinda continues to thrive and enjoy her life in her Bello Machre community home. She loves her housemates and the staff that care for her — especially Antoinette, her Family Living Director. When she isn't attending a local day program, she enjoys going to the movies and shopping. At home, she has fun eating dinner with her housemates or curling up to watch her favorite TV show, Family Feud.

Bel is thrilled knowing how fulfilling Belinda's life is at Bello Machre. Most importantly, she can rest assured knowing that Belinda will receive a lifetime of loving care. Bel sums up her feelings: *It is truly a blessing to have peace of mind. I know that Belinda will always be cared for in a safe, loving home.* 🌻

I am so glad I came to Bello Machre, Alexis concludes. I feel loved and included — this is the place where I want to be. 🌻

Generous Community Grant Partners

Our amazing grant partners continued to make numerous funding opportunities available for Bello Machre this past year. Filling gaps in funding at Bello Machre, our 2022 grantors prove again that we are part of a very generous, enduring community.

A permanent dedication was made in 2014 honoring the longstanding generosity of the Hertha S. and Jesse L. Adams Trust. The Bello Machre Ray of Hope Program is named in honor of Hertha and Jesse Adams and in recognition of the trust's ongoing generosity. Carl and Carole Brudin were instrumental to introducing Jesse Adams to Bello Machre.

Arundel Community Development Services, which administers grants through the Anne Arundel County Executive's Office, provided a very generous community support grant in the amount of \$15,000 to purchase start-up supplies for five new individuals admitted into our Residential Services program. With the funds awarded, we were able to provide bedroom furniture, bed linens, towels, and other necessary supplies to make our folks as comfortable at home as possible. The Anne Arundel County Executive's Office has generously funded projects and programs for Bello Machre for eleven years, totaling approximately \$116,000.

Hertha S. and Jesse L. Adams Charitable Trust: Generosity continued with their gifts totaling \$60,326 in support of the Hertha and Jesse Adams Ray of Hope Program, helping families in our community and individuals we support with unfunded items such as physical and occupational therapy, co-pays for medical appointments, prescription medication, summer camp expenses, adaptive equipment, and transportation to out-of-state specialists. The Adams Charitable Trust has partnered with Bello Machre for over twenty years and has given over \$921,000.

Kathy and Jerry Wood Foundation continued its support of the Bello Machre Meaningful Day Program with a \$25,000 grant. This grant helps young adults with developmental disabilities obtain job skills training and community job placement. The Kathy and Jerry Wood Foundation has been a partner of Bello Machre for nearly ten years, giving \$200,000 in grant funding.

Maryland Affordable Housing Trust (MAHT) awarded a \$58,196 grant to Bello Machre in 2022 to purchase four, full-home generators for our homes at Millersville Road, Otis Drive, Kays Mill South, and Wright Road. MAHT has funded projects for Bello Machre for ten years and has given approximately \$319,000.

Phillips Charitable Foundation awarded Bello Machre with a \$116,500 grant to be used as the down payment for Bello Machre's next state-of-the-art, fully-accessible home, which will be named in honor of Howard W. Phillips, Jr., the namesake of the Phillips Charitable Foundation. Located in Hanover, MD, the property will be the forever home for four adults in critical need of accessible housing. An open house and dedication are expected to take place in Spring 2023. The Phillips Charitable Foundation has been a generous grantor of Bello Machre for five years, providing \$186,500 in funding to date.



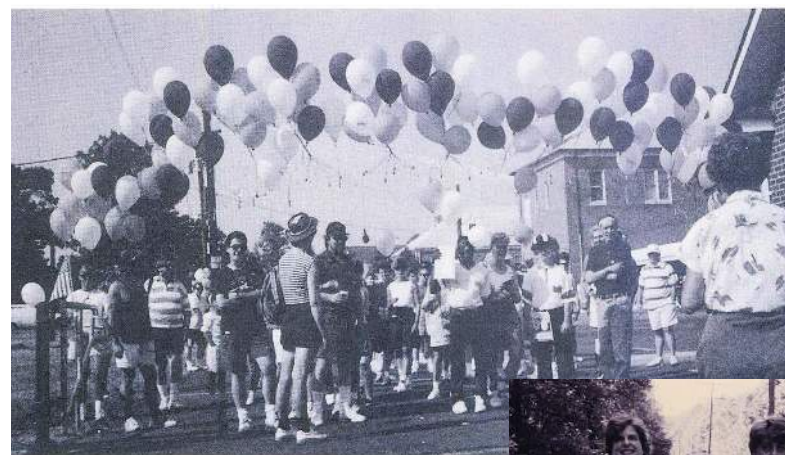

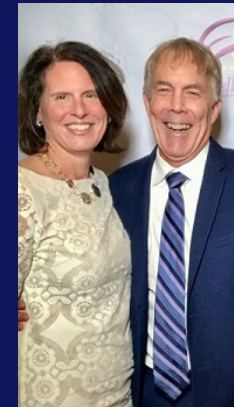
